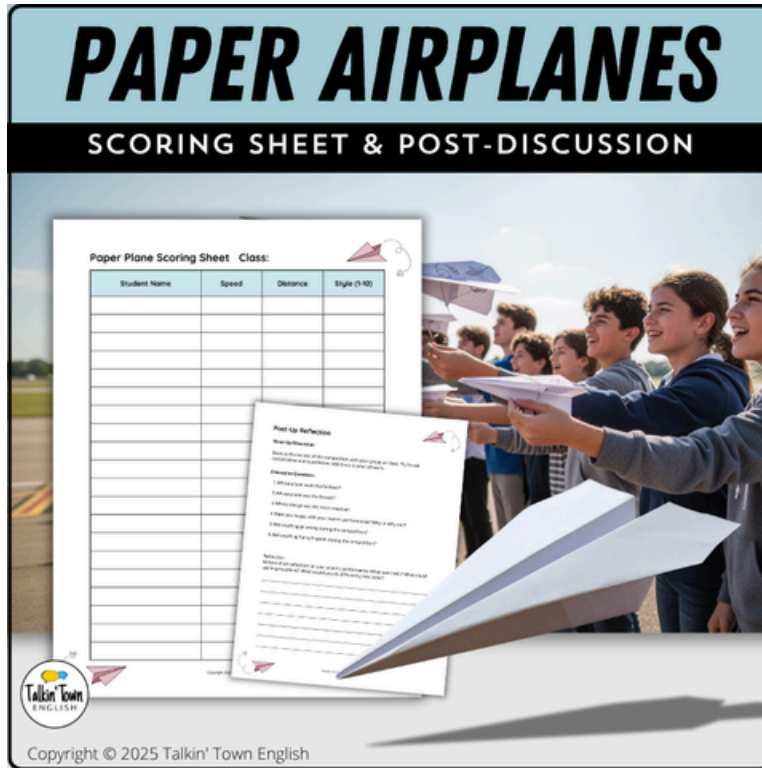

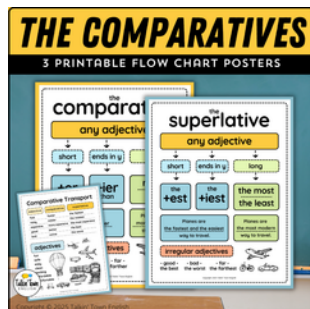

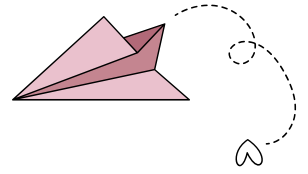

Wrap-Up Discussion

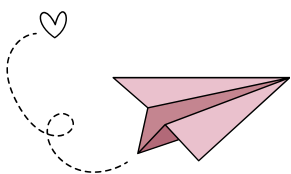
Discuss the results of the competition with your group or class. Try to use comparative and superlative adjectives in your answers.
